**17/18** **APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE:** Received from County & Borough Cllr. D Bastiman (prior commitment).

**18/18** **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST:** None.

**19/18** **MINUTES**

Having been previously circulated, the minutes of the meeting of 11th May 2018 were **approved** as an accurate record & signed by the Chairman.

**PROCEDURAL ITEM** – No suspension of Standing Orders as no public present.

**20/18** **PUBLIC OPEN FORUM** None present.

**21/18** **MATTERS RAISED IN THE PUBLIC OPEN FORUM** None.

**22/18** **REPORTS**

- a) **Police:** Written report **received**.
- b) **County:** No report to receive.
- c) **Borough:** On behalf of Borough Cllr. Bastiman, the Clerk gave an update on the fly tipping matter raised by Cllr. Foxtton at the last meeting [Minute 11/18c) refers] – SBC wouldn't clear isolated litter on land not owned by them but would clear the highway verge, also if anyone wanted to gather up stray litter and put it next to the roadside then SBC would collect it if they were made aware. Cllr. Foxtton did not accept this update answered his concerns and it was **agreed** Clerk would inform Cllr. Bastiman and ask him to contact Cllr. Foxtton direct.
- d) **Clerk:** No matters to report.

**23/18** **2018 PARISH ASSEMBLY** Draft minutes had been circulated with the agenda. **Confirmed** as an accurate record.

**24/18** **GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATIONS (GDPR)** [Minute 13/18d) refers] **Noted** the legislation had been amended and Parish Councils were exempt from the obligation to appoint a Data Protection Officer.

**25/18** **UPDATES ON ITEMS RAISED AT MAY MEETING**

1] Parishioner's problems with Highdales Road [Minute 14/18 refers] **Noted** Highways had carried out some work on the drainage, landowners had carried out work on overhanging trees. A letter of thanks had been received in which the parishioner was "very grateful for your time and greatly impressed by your professionalism". 2] Height signs for Hackness bridge [Minute 74/17 refers]. The Clerk summarised an exchange of emails with Highways. **Agreed** Clerk to go back to Highways – drivers who didn't see/couldn't understand/ignored the low bridge signs or used a car satnav in a HGV were the problem. By the time they saw the bridge there was a lack of adequate turning places. People coming from Scalby/Suffield needed to be told no later than Suffield that the 10'3" bridge prevented high vehicles accessing Hackness. Similarly people from the western villages needed to know no later than Hackness Village Hall that the 10'3" bridge prevented access to Suffield/Scalby.

**26/18** **COUNCILLOR'S REPORTS**

Cllr. Mrs Hugill - the hedge at Wyatt's Cottage was still overhanging the pavement.  
Cllr. Lockey - the gully next to the phone box had not been covered over before the re-surfacing took place and as a consequence it had been re-surfaced!!  
Cllr. Dickinson - numerous potholes on the stretch of Broxa Moor Lane from The Bungalow to where it went into the forestry - Clerk to pass all matters to Highways

for action. Cllr. Chapman - several parishioners had asked for centre white lines on the double bends near Suffield Farm and Cllr. Foxton - asked for an update from Highways re. the proposed weight/length restriction on The Windings since it was now over four years since the matter had been first raised - Clerk to contact Highways re. both matters.

**27/18**    **FINANCE & GENERAL PURPOSES MATTERS**

- a) **Verge cutting 2018/19** [Minute 75/17a) refers] - **agreed** a second cut should take place to include all verges including the wildflower ones. Cut to be done after significant rain (so probably mid-late August). Clerk to liaise with Mr Flinton (contractor).

**28/18**    **CORRESPONDENCE**

- a) Email from NYCC dated 22/5/18 - the 7 Area Committees had ceased to exist. They had been replaced by 6 Area Constituency Committees. **Noted.**  
b) Correspondence received after 5/7/18 & requiring a response next meeting - None.

**29/18**    **PLANNING MATTERS**

a) **Applications received:**

- 1] NYM/2018/0343/FL Erect three sections of boundary fence at St. Athanasius' Monastery, Langdale End - **agreed** no objections, but any hedging in line of fence be preserved where possible and request condition that fence be painted matt black or dark green & so maintained (Council didn't wish to see gold or other decorative painting on fence as it would make area look too urban);

b) **Decisions received**

The following were **noted:-**

- 1] NYM/2018/0042/FL - replacement stable building with associated hardstanding at Chapel Farm, Harwood Dale - **granted**;  
2] NYM/2018/0191/FL Erect 30metre lattice mast with antennae & dishes plus ground based equipment cabinets, generator, fencing & access track, land to north west of Birch Hall, Langdale End - **granted**;

c) **Planning items received after 5/7/2018:** None.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting closed at 7.45pm.
